Things to know:

- Application approval goes through a series of levels within the organization and is not decided immediately nor by only one individual. We will prioritize your application and contact you with a response within 7 business days following your submission.
- We are limited in space for large paintings, prints, photographs, and other forms of 2-D artwork in the Gallery Shop. Please consider a Solo Art Exhibition Application if you are looking to sell large quantities of these types of works.
- If approved, you will be required to provide up to three high-resolution, digital images of your art for print media, a photograph of yourself (the artist), and an artist statement. This information may be turned into a press release for potential publication in newspapers, our social media, etc.
- We cannot guarantee sales; you are welcome to share our media posts and promote the sale of your pieces once in the shop.
- You must provide a W-9 form for Panama City Center for the Arts to sell your work. Typical gross earnings for Artists is 70% of the sale amount with the remaining 30% going back into Bay Arts Alliance to help keep the center free to the public. Further details are provided in the Consignment Contract if your application is approved.
- Application submission is limited to once quarterly; but reapplying is strongly encouraged.
- All applicants considered for the Gallery Shop must be current members of Bay Arts Alliance. All are welcome to become members using our website and paying a small, annual fee.
- If you have related class ideas or want to lead an instruction yourself, please include those details in the email.
